Mission Statement

The mission of Covenant Christian Technology and Arts Academy is to spiritually and academically assist students in their pursuit of God-directed careers. Their unique skills and talents will be channeled through an intense program which focuses on individualized learning with high spiritual, academic, technological, and artistic standards.

Background

CCS Technology and Arts Academy provides students and parents with an alternative in the types of educational opportunities and programs that are available within the Christian school community.

The CCS School Board approved a Christian high school in the year 2000. The school consists of the following programs:

- *Media Communications Program* (provides instruction in photography, journalism, broadcasting and filmmaking)
- *Performing and Fine Arts Program* (focuses on the performing, vocal/instrumental, fine arts, and academic instruction)
- *Discipleship and Mission Outreach Program* (training in Bible and Missions with actual local/world field experiences)

Glorifying God through Mission Outreaches



All programs focus on individualized methods of instruction and assessment to meet the needs of the students. Programs include high academic standards, active parental and community involvement, as well as individualized learning plans and spiritual discipleship accountability.

Curriculum

Student courses include formal and informal instruction with individual and group practice in the following areas:

Academic Courses: These courses will reflect compliance to the State of Illinois graduation requirements of math, science, English, social sciences, arts, and P.E./Health. They will provide the basis of student academic work and will utilize innovative methods of instruction in traditional and non-traditional learning environments.

Core Classes: These classes are designed to give students exposure to and provide students with a broad experience in two areas of technology and three areas of the fine and performing arts. These survey courses will touch upon stylistic genres and historical background in each of the arts, Bible/missions, and technology areas.

Emphasis Courses: These upper level classes will be technology based with input from professional artists and technicians in the church and community. Classes will focus on one area of specialization in technology and the arts and will enhance and refine student skills. (These courses may have prerequisites.)

These strands form the basis by which each student's individualized learning plan will be developed. Students will receive training through technology in media tracks that will enable them to pursue possible careers in computer science, engineering, programming, radio and television production, education, and photography. Those in the art tracks will receive training to prepare them for careers in graphic arts/architectural design, fashion and interior design, musical and artistic pursuits, mission, and education. All students will receive Bible/Missions training to prepare them for a Biblical worldview and Christian ministry.
